1990 Professor and founder of the classical guitar department of the Conservatory of Timişoara

1990 and 1991 participates in Jazz Festival Debrecen Hungary, sharing the same stage with Elvin Jones, Charles Lloyd, Charlie Mariano, Larry Corryell, Niels-Henning Oersted-Pedersen, Aladar Pege

1991 Vice President of the Romanian Association of Jazz

1992 attending the Festival in Montreux, Switzerland, where playing for His Majesty King Michael of Romania

1993 launches the first disc of blues-jazz Romanian " Blues de Timişoara " with the Bega Blues Band

1997-2017 participates in the jazz-festival Brebu-Garana, among whose founders are, next to BBB, Paul Weiner, Puba Hromadka, Istvan Gyarfas, Miloš Krstić, Liviu Butoi, Kamo

2001 comes to organize, with CCF of Timişoara, the first international jazz masterclass in Timişoara, taught by excellent jazzmen such as: Manuel Rocheman, Sylvain Beuf, Istvan Gyárfás, Gyuri Jeszenski, Miloš Krstić, Stéphane Kerecki

2002 attends, along with German pianist and drummer Günter Buchwald and Romanian drummer Dinu Simon, the first international film festival "Transylvania" in Cluj, performing "live" soundtrack "Nosferatu," directed by Murnau

2002 plays in the town of Sao Luis in Brazil, along with the famous blues guitarist Kenny Brown in the music festival "Um Canto de los povos por la Harmonia"

2002 attends the Sibiu Jazz Festival, appearing on the same stage with famous Belgian guitarist Jean "Toots" Thielemans

2003 March 8, appears in the extraordinary concert called "From Gershwin to Sting", at the Opera House in Timişoara, in celebration of twenty years of existence of his Bega Blues Band. Soloists were Alexandra Guţu, Mirela Zafiri, Istvan Gyárfás Liviu Butoi, Toni Kühn and Mircea Bunea, accompanied by the Philharmonic Orchestra "Banat" in Timişoara, led by maestro Cristian Oroşanu. Bota wrote the whole music concert, the first of its kind, combining jazz with blues, rock and symphonic music

2003 November reissuing the success of the show "From Gershwin to Sting" in the framework of the 13th edition of the jazz festival in Timişoara

2003 introduces American band Oregon, in Timişoara, in a concert organized by the Cores company

2004 gets, along with BBB, the Award for best band blues of the year, equivalent to a vernacular Grammy, in a great concert, on the stage of the Radio Hall in Bucharest with such guests as Istvan

Gyárfás Mirela Zafiri and Mircea Bunea, and accompanied by the Bucharest Radio Big Band, conducted by Ionel Tudor

2004 Bota became a member of the Composers and Musicologists Union of Romania

2004 the Timişoara City Hall offers the BBB Diploma of Excellence "for all musical activity and for promoting the image of Timişoara in the country and abroad"

2004 plays the bass score of "Concerto for saxophone and orchestra" by Sabin Pautza in the Timişoara Philharmonic, a work directed by the author himself featuring soloist Nicolas Simion

2005 organized the first International Symposium Jazz Jupîneşti with the participation of American jazz seven teachers, such as Tom Smith, Brian Torff, Tom Wolfe, Rick Condit, and 40 Romanian students and teachers

2005 October established the first College of jazz and pop in Romania within the "Tibiscus" University of Timişoara, which gives its name "Richard Oschanitzky" in honor of the most important Romanian jazz composer, born in Timişoara

2005, 2006, the prize for jazz, awarded by the Union of Composers magazine, "Music News"

2006 January participates as a representative of the Romanian academic jazz, IAJE Convention in New York

2006 organizes the second edition of the International Symposium Jazz Jupîneşti

2006 participate in Garana Jazz Festival with the BBB accompanying American jazz vocalist Karen Gallinger

2006 participates in the Festival of Paks, Hungary Gastroblues sharing the same scene with Chris Farlow ex- Colosseum and Keith Emerson

2006 is touring Hungary, Slovakia and Serbia together with Eldad Tarmu Ensemble and recorded with the CD "Songs for the Queen of Bohemia"

2006-2007 plays with BBB at the Timişoara Opera Square New Year, marking Romania's EU entry

2007 celebrates 25 years of the band Bega Blues Band with a festive concert held March 3 in Room CNA "Ion Vidu", accompanied by the Philharmonic Orchestra of Timişoara, with special guest Moni Bordeianu, the first singer of the band " Phoenix "

2007 plays with BBB, invited by the Polish Cultural Institute, the famous clubs "Tygmont" in Warsaw and "Pivnica Baranemia Bridge" in Krakow

2008 IAJE attend the International Conference in New York, as representative of the Romanian university jazz

2008 is organizing the third edition of the International Symposium Jazz Jupîneşti with the participation of famous Romanian artists Eugen Gondi, Alex Simu, Catalin Milea and some foreign teachers valued: Mike Krstić (Serbia), Tom Wolfe (USA), Tom Smith (USA), Karen Gallinger (USA) Tarmu Eldad (USA)

2008 starts along with Eldad Tarmu Strings Group a tour in Hungary and Slovakia to promote music disc "Songs for the Queen of Bohemia" and appears at TV Bratislava broadcast

2008 invited as a teacher "in residence" at the Faculty of Jazz in Basel (Switzerland)

In January 2010, after the death of Bela Kamocsa, which was his colleague for 25 years in the BBB, Bota organizes a farewell concert at Club 30, with over 25 invited musicians trademark of Timişoara

2010 Bega Blues Band restored by Bota, keeping from the old formula only drummer Lica Dolga

2010 March participates with the BBB in Valjevo Jazz Festival

2010 plays at the Unirii Square in Timişoara with BBB at Europe Day

2010 is touring eight cities in Romania with jazz USA big bands jazz from the University of Northern Colorado and Louisiana McNeese, featuring soloists Sasha Bota, Alex Man and Luiza Zan

August 2010, becomes the director of the festival "Blues for Timişoara"

2010 plays with his son Sasha Bota, and with Istvan Gyárfás and son Gyarfas Attila at the Unirii Square in Timişoara, within the event "Timişoara-Little Vienna"

2010 Bota becomes the director of Gala Blues Jazz Kamo in Timişoara, playing with the BBB and featuring guest the French singer Pierre Trégomain. After that, they performed in important Romanian towns such as Cluj, Braşov, Iaşi, Bucharest, Sfîntu Gheorghe

2010 plays at ICR in Budapest and Szeged, with Csaba Deseo, Attila Juhasz and Eugen Gondi

2010 plays at ICR in London, together with the BBB

In 2011 the prize for best Romanian jazz band of the year with the Bega Blues Band, in a ceremony held at Dalles Hall in Bucharest

2011 performs at the Romanian National Opera Hall in Timişoara, an Astor Piazzolla anniversary concert, along with the Nuevo Tango Quintet: Sasha Bota-violin, Alin Stoianovici-harmonica, Roxana Coşereanu-piano and Ionuţ Dorobanţu- guitar

2011 organized a series of so-called "Unplugged Concerts", as an artistic director, at the County Council Hall

2011 November is the artistic director of Jazz Kamo Blues gala in Timişoara playing along with the Bega Blues Band, featuring twenty years reunion with colleagues in the Quartet Gondi: Eugen Gondi, Dan Ionescu, Toni Kühn

2012 two concerts with the Nuevo Tango Quintet at ArCuB in Bucharest, organized with support of the Embassy of Argentina and the Cervantes Foundation, with full house

Get the prize for journalism in 2012 for his book "The history of jazz Breviar", awarded by the Foundation and the Union of Composers Muzza

2012 August 11 to 12, Bota is the artistic director of the "Blues for Timişoara" festival

2013 attended the "Razelm" revival concert in Bucharest, together with Eugen Gondi, Toni Kühn, Nicolas Simion Ion Baciu Junior Liviu Butoi, Garbis Dedeian, in memory of the "Razelm" period, at Black Sea resort Venus

2013 continues as artistic director, "Unplugged Concert" series, held at Timis County Council, presenting bands like: Lucian Ban - Matt Maneri from New York, Iordache, Sebastian Trio Spanache, Aquarium, Mikuta Trio

2013 May 22, organizes and writes scores for the Banatul Philharmonic Orchestra, the musical program that celebrates the anniversary of 30 years of the group Bega Blues Band. The concert, conducted by Maestro Radu Popa, he had as guests, Alexandra Gutu - cello, Moni Bordeianu - voice, Mircea Bunea - guitar, Aura Twarowska - mezzo. On this occasion, the band Bega Blues Band, was granted the second Diploma of Excellence by the Municipality of Timişoara

2013 performs, along with Toni Kühn, a series of concerts organized by the Banat Philharmonic, introducing the violin to Timişoara youth, and Faget, Jimbolia

2013 May organizes jazz master classes at the Faculty of Music in Timişoara, held by American Tom Wolfe, Professor of the University of Alabama, completed by a concert

2013 May concerts with the Bega Blues Band, at Posticum Jazz Festival in Oradea

2013 June concerts at Jimbo Blues, with the Bega Blues Band

2013 in July, plays the opening concert Jazz Festival Timişoara, with Bega Blues Band and vocalist Aura Twarowska, accompanied by the Banatul Philharmonic Orchestra, conducted by maestro Peter Oschanitzky

2013 August is the festival's artistic director Blues for Timişoara held in the Opera Square, and plays with his Bega Blues Band
