

## Iulia Luță

### Biography



Iulia Luță is respected for her expertise proven in artistic tuition, being therefore awarded Republic of Moldavia's Culture Ministry 1st Degree Diploma (2010, and *Ciprian Porumbescu* Republican Music High School's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary 1st Degree Diploma (2015); she also owns the High Didactic Degree, as a violin professor.

Born on March, 18.03.1965, violinist Iulia Luță graduated *Gavriil Musicescu* State Conservatory, with a diploma confirming her expertise as orchestra player, orchestra conductor, and violin professor.

Over her 31 long work practice as violin professor, Iulia Luță owned formal positions with *Gavril Musicescu* State Conservatory (1989 to 1994), *Ștefan Neagra* Music College (1989 to 2001) and *Ciprian Porumbescu* Republican Music High School (1989 to present day).

Iulia Luță also attended UNESCO National Committee for Republic Moldavia's seminar *Modern Practices in World Arts Education*, covering public classes, concerts and master classes (1998). One more training stage Iulia Luță attended was UNESCO National Committee for Republic Moldavia's Republican Seminar *Modern Methods and Targets in Tuition for the Arts* (2004), covering public classes and concerts.

Iulia Luță took part in a series of trainings of the Institute for Education Sciences, Music Pedagogy Department, in 2002, 2007, 2011, 2013 and 2017, benefitting from the public classes, lectures, seminars and master classes of great artists and professors such as Sofia Propiscean and Galina Buinovschi (Moldavia), Mihail Gotsdiner (Russia), Elena Ovănescu-Pârvu (Romania), Patricia Copacinski (Austria) and Filipp Draganov (Switzerland).

Iulia Luță was member of the jury in various competitions, such as *Modest Ifinchi* World Violin Competition (Bucharest, 2017) and *Ștefan Neaga* Competition for Young Violinists (Kishinev).

Iulia Luță's former students own orchestra positions in Moldavia and worldwide (e.g. Italy, USA, Canada and Lebanon); her students these days, frequently take part in national and world competitions and concerts held in *Ciprian Porumbescu* High School, *G. Musicescu* Music Academy and *Lunchevici National Philharmonic Orchestra* (Republic of Moldavia).
